This Week's Quick Fishing Report

Best Local Fishing Spot:

Lake Henderson – shallow grass flats on the north end

Fish Species Biting:

Largemouth Bass, Crappie, Bluegill

Best Bait or Lures:

White spinnerbaits, green pumpkin soft plastics, live shiners

Best Time to Fish:

Early morning before 10 AM and again near sunset

Water Conditions:

Temp: 68°F
Clarity: Slightly stained

Pro Tips from the Tackle Shop

Tip of the Week

As water temperatures warm up, bass are starting to move shallow to feed. Focus on grassy areas near drop-offs and work spinnerbaits slowly through the grass. If the bite slows down, switch to a soft plastic worm and fish it slowly along the bottom.

Recommended Gear This Week

Rod & Reel Setup

Medium-heavy baitcasting rod with a 7:1 gear ratio reel

Line Recommendation

15 lb fluorocarbon or 30 lb braid

Best Lures or Baits

- ½ oz white spinnerbait
 - Green pumpkin stick worm
 - Live shiners

What to Wear on the Water

Conditions this week: Warm mornings with windy afternoons

Recommended clothing:

- Lightweight sun shirt
 - Hat and polarized sunglasses
 - Light rain jacket in case storms roll through
